



# PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

have read and understand the following code of conduct, and I agree to follow these principles. Every parent within the Oregon Premier Football Club is expected to follow a code of conduct that promotes healthy competition, sportsmanship, accountability, and overall good citizenship within the community. To fulfill this expectation, every player and a parent are required to agree to the following:

- 1) OPFC parents will behave appropriately on social media. Posts must not contain, or link to, libelous, defamatory or harassing content – this also applies to the use of illustrations or nicknames.
- 2) OPFC parents will inform the coach of any physical disability, injury or ailment that may affect the safety of their child or the safety of others.
- 3) OPFC parents will learn and follow the rules of the game and the policies of OPFC.
- 4) OPFC parents will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- 5) OPFC parents will demand that their child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- 6) OPFC parents will NOT coach their child and they will never ridicule or yell at their child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 7) OPFC parents will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field or away from the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- 8) OPFC parents will demand a sports environment for their child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and parents and players will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
